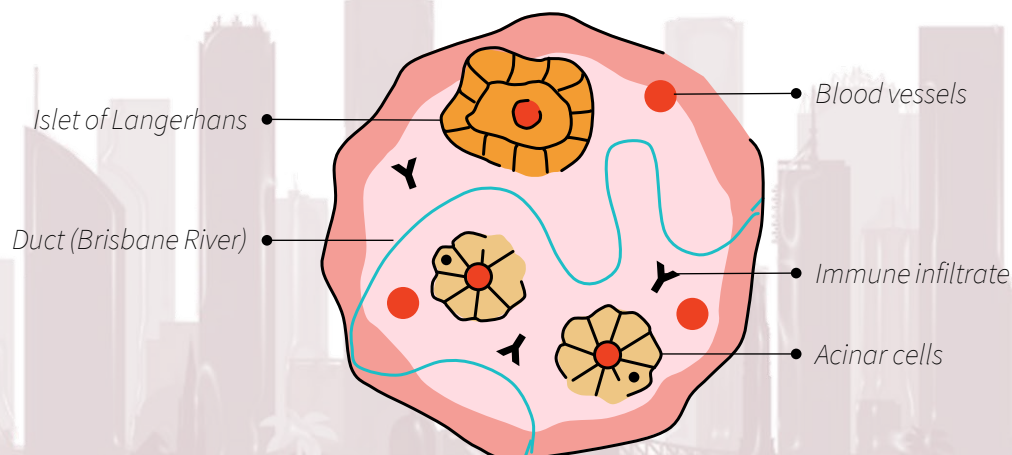

Introduction to the IDS

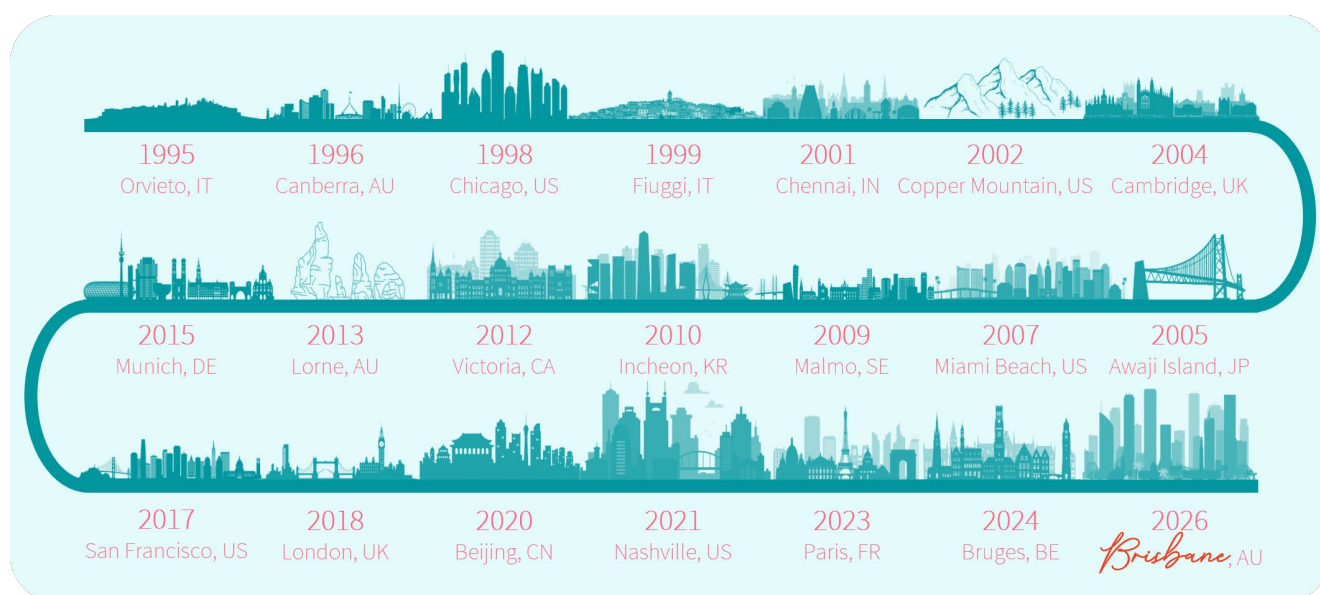
About the IDS

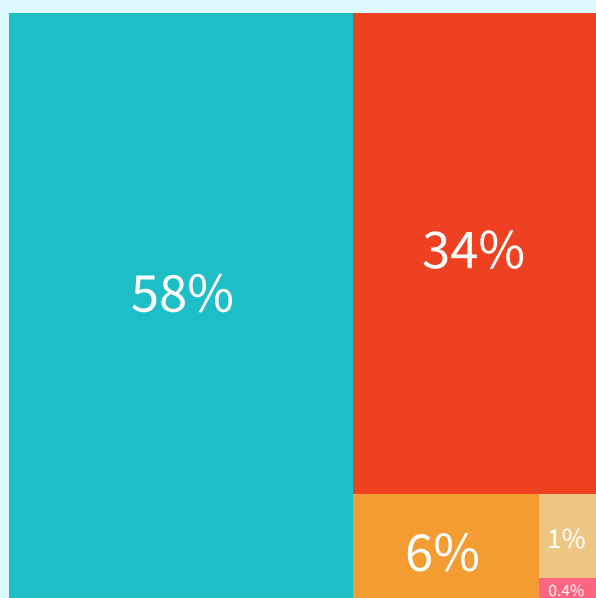

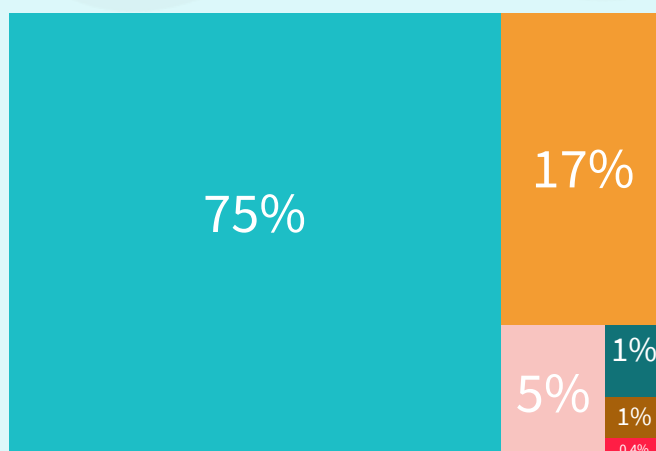

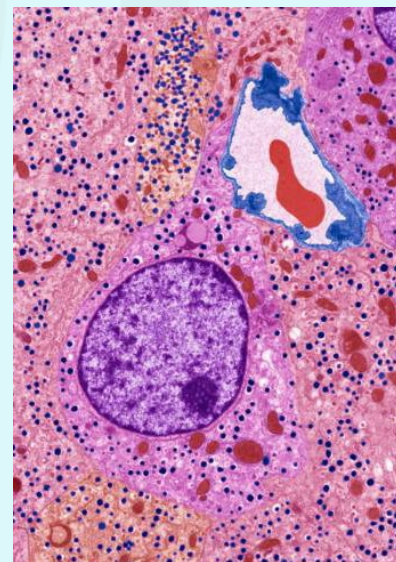
IDS Membership Profile

Promote Young Investigators and Diversity in Research

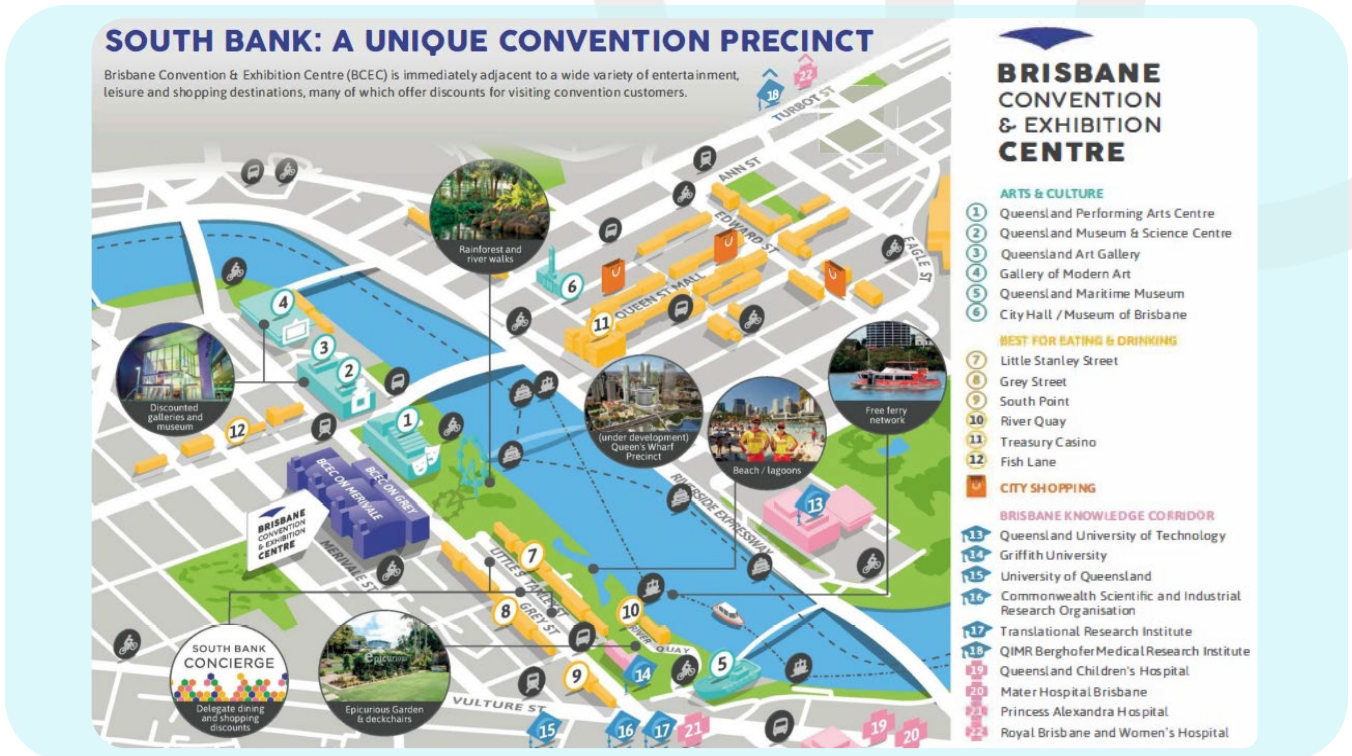

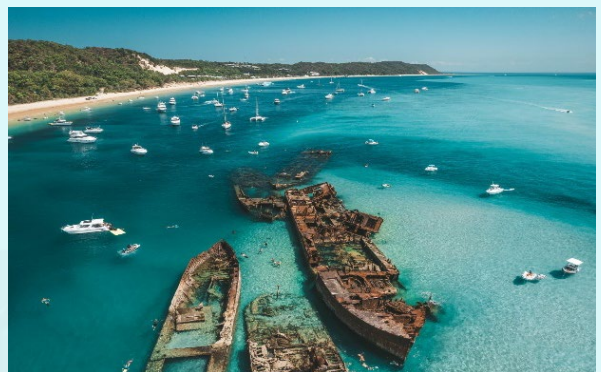

Cultural and Recreational Richness

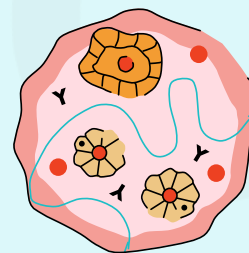

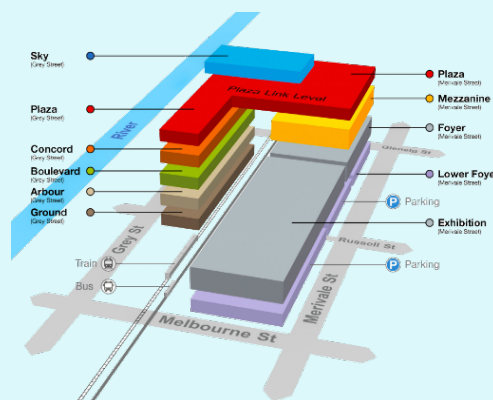
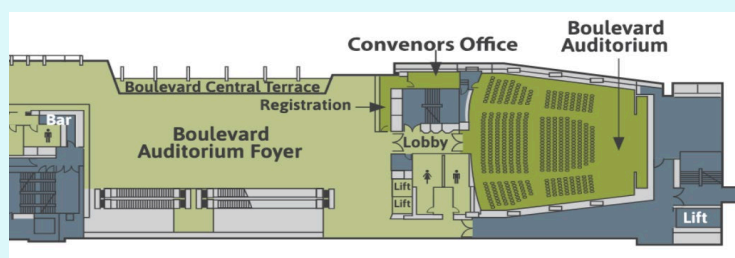
Trade Display

Cancellation Policy

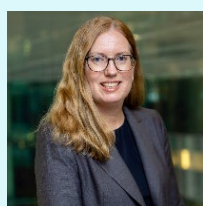
1. In the event of cancellation received by you in writing prior to/on 1 January 2026, you are liable for 50% of the sponsorship package selected.
